


- In December 2021, Coherent Digital acquired the Taylor & Francis digital primary-source collections

Important

Underrepresented

Less than 4% of Western library collections

South Asia Archive





- 4.5 million pages of research material
- Content dated 1700-1953
- The entire Indian subcontinent is represented
- Most of the collection is in English—with 15% in vernacular languages, primarily Bengali and Sanskrit
- Designed for both research and teaching




Great content, but...
